You may pay the balance of fees at any time up to the course start date of **14th March 2026** or by eight instalments of **£151.25 beginning 14th March 2026**, by standing order or online by Paypal.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

By signing this page you are signing a legal agreement with the Goddess Temple – please read carefully

1. To complete the course students are expected to attend every training weekend and to complete all homework on time. Failure to do may result in a fine or a student being asked to leave the course.
2. For the duration of the Priestess Training course within Goddess Temple Teachings, with very occasional exceptions, students cannot take more than one Priestess Training at the same time, whether such courses are within Goddess Temple Teachings or offered from an outside source.
3. A course place is only secured on the acceptance of a completed application form and receipt of a non-refundable deposit, **paid within four weeks of acceptance onto the course**, or as stated in the course application form if you have applied within four weeks of the course start date. If, for any reason, a student is **not** accepted the deposit is, of course, refunded. We advise students to take out independent cancellation insurance to protect against loss in the event of illness, injury, jury service and other difficulties preventing the completion of a course. You would receive back your deposit and any other fees paid in advance to the Temple in full in the event of The Glastonbury Goddess Temple cancelling the course for any reason.
4. By signing this agreement you confirm that we may keep on file the details you have given us in your application for the training and any subsequent communications. We will keep your details for no more than seven years from your application. It's also important that we are able to get in touch with you quickly during the run up to the beginning of the training and throughout the life of the course, and you therefore also agree to us contacting you by email, regular mail, telephone or SMS. You must inform of us any change in contact details.
5. Course fees are to be paid in full prior to the course start date or by deposit paid as in clause 4 above, followed by 8 instalments, by standing order or by PayPal (eight monthly instalment payments involve an additional one-off fee of £50 covering Paypal or banking costs). Late payment of instalments without pre-arranged good cause may result in a fine of £5 per late payment. You also need to inform us if you're paying by instalments and change your method of payment during the course, otherwise we incur additional admin fees which may also need to be passed on to you.
6. Students are responsible for their own well-being at all times and must inform the teacher of any matters affecting their health for the duration of the course.
7. Because the nature of the course is transformative, students who are in need may be required to undertake additional psychotherapeutic counselling to help them address personal issues, in order to continue with the course.
8. The course tutor reserves the right to ask a student to leave the course.
9. All students shall respect the other course participants irrespective of race, colour, creed or gender and will endeavour to respect any values that may be different from their own.
10. Confidentiality provides privacy and safety within the group. Whilst there is no automatic presumption that all information given is confidential, students must work within the guideline that all personal information about group members is confidential.
11. Should difficulties arise with another member of the group, students must call upon the group, the Tutor, or the Glastonbury Goddess Temple for mediation and resolution.
12. Should difficulties arise between the student and the Course Tutor the student can call upon the Glastonbury Goddess Temple for mediation and resolution.

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13. Students who pay for the whole course in advance and leave the course before the second weekend will receive a refund of the full fee minus the deposit and the payment for the first weekend. There is no refund after the second weekend has been taken.
14. Students who pay by instalments and then leave the course before the second weekend do not receive a refund, but pay up to and including the month in which they inform the tutor that they are not continuing the course. Students who leave the course after the second weekend are expected to complete all instalment payments, as their place has been reserved for them for the duration of the course.
15. Goddess Temple Teachings courses require a minimum number of students to run.

Care of Students

The Glastonbury Goddess Temple or any tutor are not, and will not, be held liable for any assumed damage that is deemed to occur at any time.
